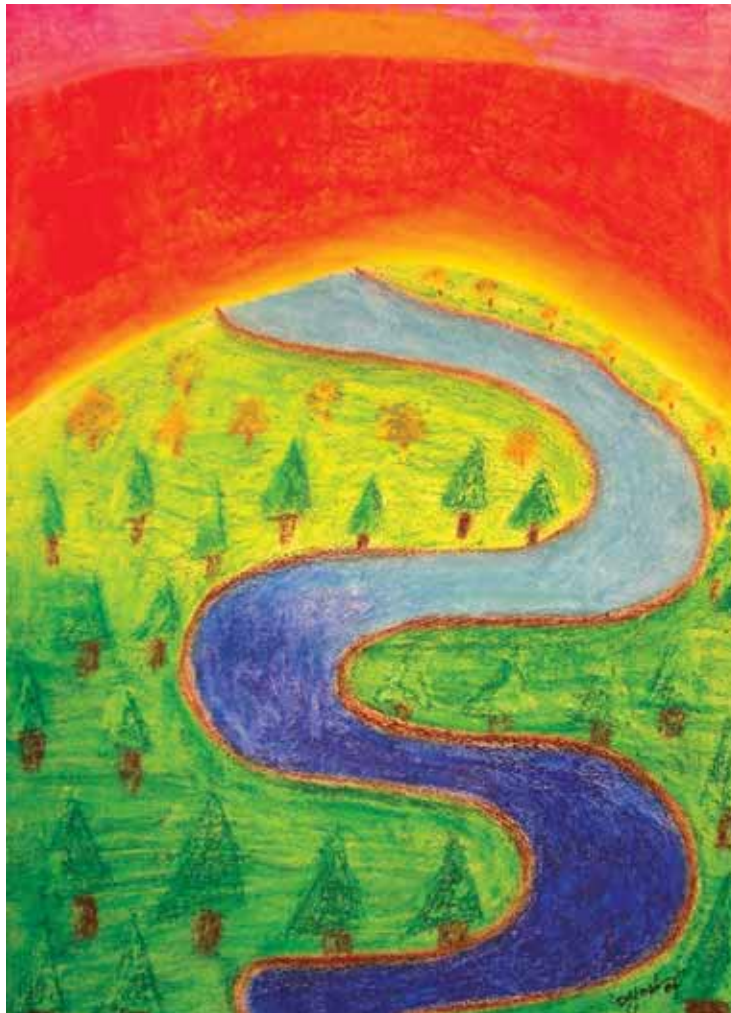
MISSION STATEMENT
